

Class Information

PPA and ALN Time

My PPA (Planning, Preparation and Assessment) time is on a Wednesday morning . I will also be out of class on a Wednesday afternoon as art of my role as ALNCo. The children will be with Mrs Williams and during this time and will continue to work on literacy and numeracy , as well as some doing dome artwork and learning about different religions.

PE

We will be doing PE on a Wednesday and Thursday afternoon. Please ensure that the children have suitable footwear for activities on these days.

Outdoor Learning/ Forest School

Outdoor Learning will take place on a Monday afternoon. Please ensure your child brings wellies and a coat.

Homework

Home work will be sent out on a Friday and should be

returned to school by the following Thursday. It will consist of a mix of literacy and numeracy tasks. I will sometimes post the homework on Teams and share the answers with the children later in the week. We Will also send out a Topic related menu over the next couple of weeks which will be optional to

complete.

Spelling

Spelling will be sent out on a Friday for children to learn ready for a test on the following Friday. Children will also have access to their spellings via J2 Spell Blast.

Times Tables

Children will be tested on their multiplication tables weekly via J2 Blast. Children will work on rapid recall of the multiplication and division facts of each multiplication table. All children will begin on x2 next Friday. J2Blast is a great way to work on your target table and will be used regularly in school as a tool to learn multiplication tables.

Reading Books

Children have been allocated a reading book in school. They also have access to Oxford Owl at home, from which you can find

reading books from their stage. I will send out login details via Seesaw. We encourage regular reading at home. Reading books will be sent home each Friday and should then be returned to school on the Monday.
